## WIN DIFFERENT PRIZES BY PARTICIPATING IN LETTER WRITING COMPETITION FOR YEAR 2012

Tanzania Posts Corporation wishes to invite **Primary** and **Secondary School students aged 15** and below to participate in the 41<sup>st</sup> Universal Postal Union (UPU) LETTER WRITING COMPETITION for the year 2012.

**THEME:** “Write a letter to an athlete or sports figure you admire, to explain what the Olympic Games mean to you”.

**LENGTH:** The **letters** and **not essays** should have words ranging between 500 and 1000

**AGE:** **15 years and below.**

**LANGUAGE:** **Kiswahili** or **English** for **Primary School pupils** and **English Only** for Secondary School students.

**PRIZE:** Different prizes shall be awarded to the first ten winners, which include hard cash, dictionaries, calculators, mathematical sets, school bags as well as certificates of participation. Furthermore, schools with the first three winners and the school with most participants will be awarded accordingly.

The letter of the first national winner will be forwarded to the Universal Postal Union Headquarters in Berne Switzerland, where it will represent Tanzania in the International Letter Writing Competition. Finally the Universal Postal Union will award special certificates, stamp albums and gold, silver and bronze medals for the first, second and third winner respectively.

The letter indicating participant’s **name, age, sex** and **name of school** should be properly addressed. Also each participant should affix a correct postage stamp on his/her letter and post it directly to
